Global Outreach and Collaboration

Triennial Meeting

The inaugural Triennial Meeting took place in Amsterdam Dec 14 – 16, 2022
Over 1,200 participants from 30 countries (24 IOTA countries)
Meeting featured 517 presentations in 79 sessions on 37 different topics

On Wednesday, December 14th, the first class of the Fellows of the IOTA (FIOTA) nominated from 19 different countries were inducted at the ceremony led by Dr. Theodore Miclau, III, MD, IOTA Steering Committee Chair, and Dr. K.J. Ponsen, MD, President Combined IOTA Triennial and Dutch Trauma Society Meeting. A total of 113 members were inducted.

2023 IOTA Observership Program

The program is currently underway. 14 IOTA societies expressed interested, and will be matched to 13 different participating institutions.

Goal: provide an opportunity for orthopaedic trauma fellows to increase the depth and breadth of clinical exposure to complex trauma patients and Level I/II Trauma Centers through 1 - 3-month observership programs.

Research Survey Project

IOTA continues to develop and enhance an international research survey program.

Current survey: Pelvis Fragility Fractures, developed by KJ Ponsen, MD from the Netherlands.

The group has piloted a new survey technique called “the snowball technique.” The overall concept is that a central group of experts is identified and they are requested to participate in the survey. The next survey is Post-Op Weight Bearing by Vincenzo Giordano from Brazil.

The Steering Committee agreed to begin offering webinars to audiences from different regions across the globe. The first webinar will be led by Zsolt Balogh from Australia. The webinar will be pre-recorded and offered via the OTA LMS.
