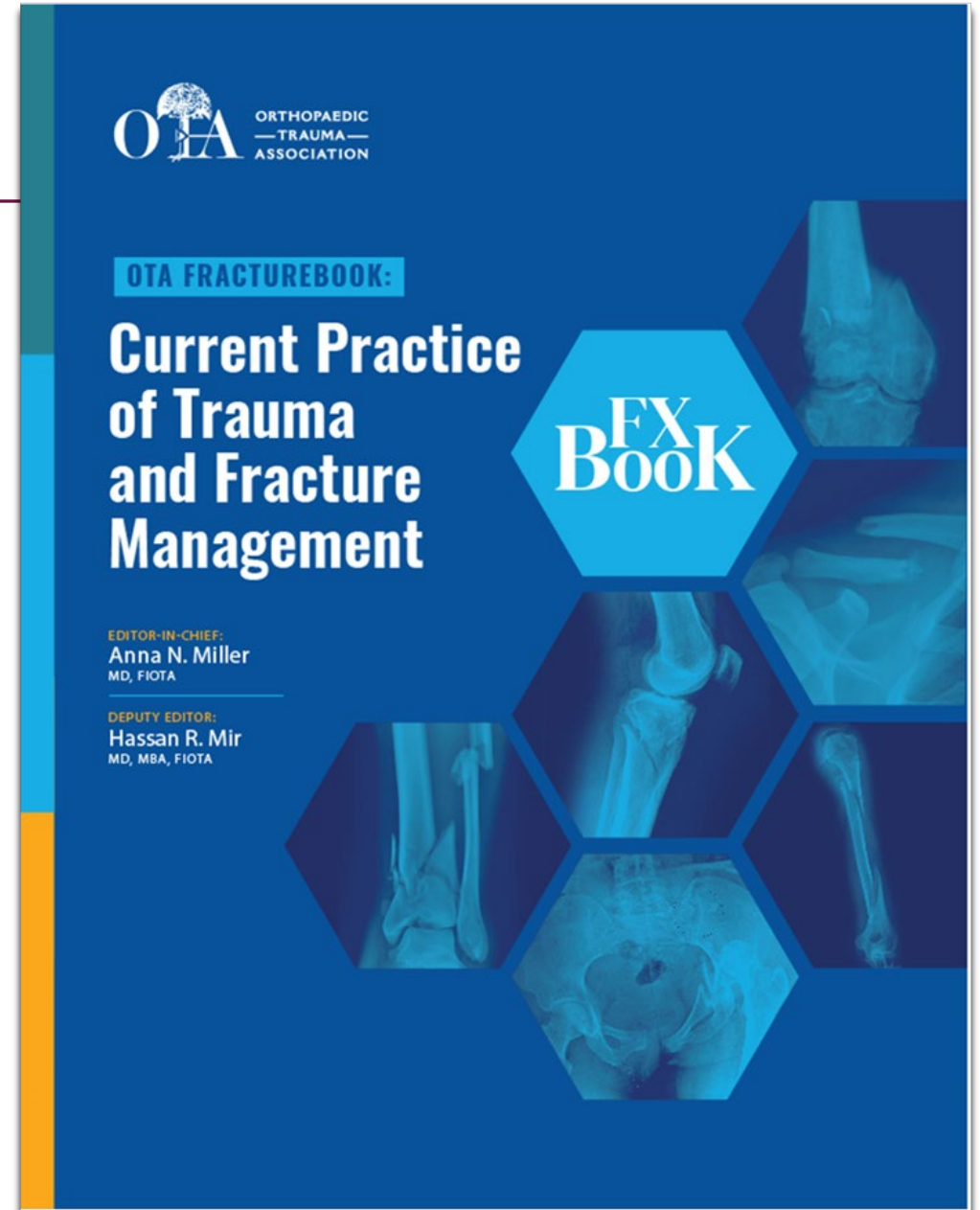

Triennial Meeting

The inaugural Triennial Meeting took place in Amsterdam Dec 14 – 16, 2022
Over 1,200 participants from 30 countries (24 IOTA countries)
Meeting featured 517 presentations in 79 sessions on 37 different topics

The first class of 113 Fellows of the IOTA (FIOTA) nominated from 19 different countries were inducted at a ceremony led by Dr. Theodore Miclau, III, MD, IOTA Steering Committee Chair, and Dr. K.J. Ponsen, MD, President Combined IOTA Triennial and Dutch Trauma Society Meeting.
