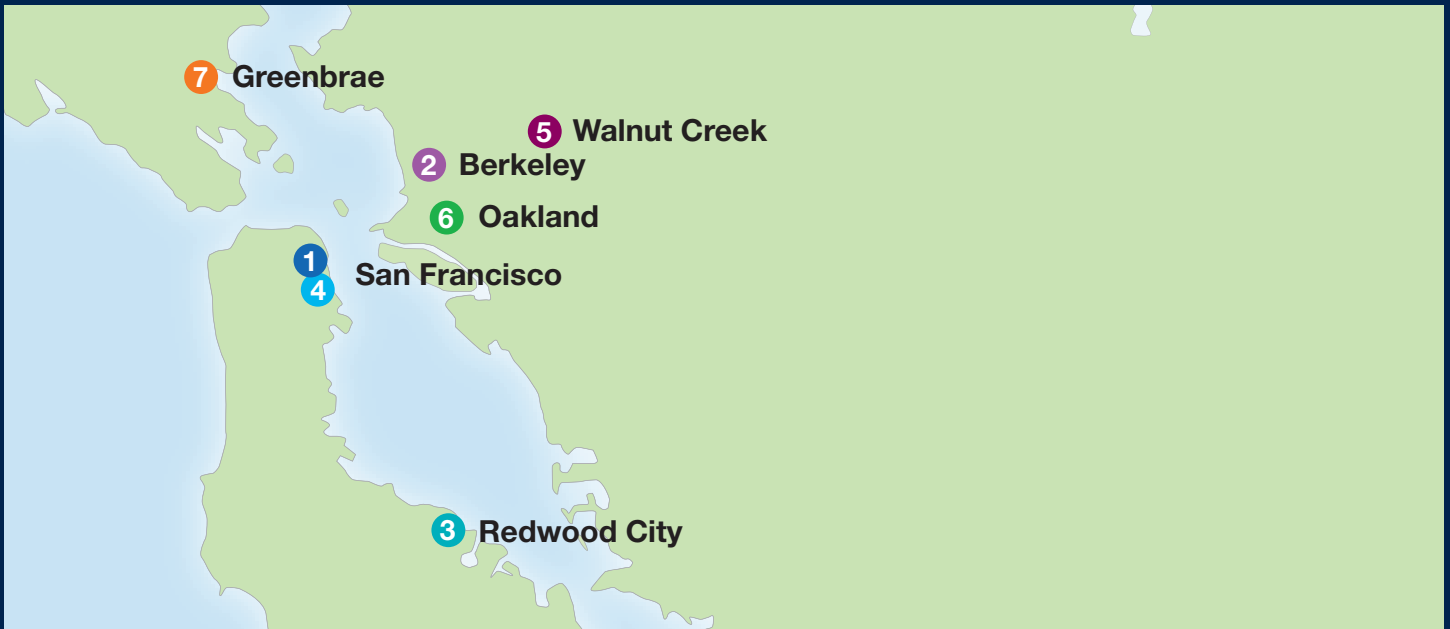


Lindsay Orbeta, MS, RD
